The Reading Diaries will be checked each morning by one of the class TA's. We expect your child to read *at least 3 times a week at home*. Your child will receive Dojo points for reading at home and completed AR tests.

Children who do not read at home a minimum of 3 times by Friday morning will read during their Friday breaktime.
