I hope you and your child/children have all had a relaxing Easter break and that you are looking forward to getting back to school! We are really looking forward to seeing you all and hearing about your Easter.

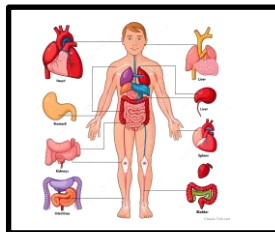
### Drop off/Pick Up

The KS1 gate will be open at **8.35am**. Please bring your child straight to the red double doors where their teacher will be waiting for them. The KS1 gate will then be opened at **3:10pm** and the children will be collected from the red double doors at **3.15pm**.



### History

This term we are learning about **heroes** and what makes someone **famous** or **significant**. The children will be finding out why **Florence Nightingale** and **Mary Seacole** are remembered for their important work in nursing and how their actions helped change healthcare.



### Science

This term we are learning about **animals including humans**. The children are exploring the **human body**, naming key **organs** and understanding the **five senses**. They are also finding out how **offspring grow and change**, and what all animals need to **survive and stay healthy**.



### RE

This term in RE our topic is **'what is my view of the world?'** Using their learning from previous units, the children will be looking inwards at their own worldview. They will consider how context has shaped the things they believe and value. They will explore how context has influenced how they live their own lives. They will also be introduced to the distinction between individual and organised worldviews, recognising examples of these from previous learning.

## Reading and Phonics

Children will continue to bring home their phonics books on a **Friday** and these need to be returned to school the following **Friday**, unless they are on the fluency program, where their books are brought home **fortnightly**. In addition to the phonics book, they will also take home a 'sharing' book that they will **not** be able to read independently and is designed to be shared with a grown-up. They may, of course, choose to read something they have at home for this instead. Sharing books will be changed on a **Monday** and **Wednesday**.



Every child will have a 'Home School Record' with their reading books for yourself to record when your child has read. Dojo points are awarded for daily reading, but only if the home school record is signed. If the home school record is not signed, or if the book is not returned to school, your child will not be able to choose a different book.

## P.E.



PE will take place every week on **Tuesday**. Please send your child to school in their PE kit with their school uniform and school shoes in a separate bag ready to get changed into after PE. All of your child's school uniform, shoes and PE kit must be named. The P.E kit should be appropriate for indoor and outdoor P.E and should consist of a **white t-shirt and black shorts**.

## Homework

Homework will be given out each Friday in the homework folder and is expected back in school on the following Thursday.

## Fruit and Water

The children will be given a healthy snack (a piece of fruit) each day. We encourage drinking water regularly so please send your child in with fresh water every day in their named water bottle.

If someone other than the usual person will be picking up your child after school, please let us know.
