Reading

The children have been very good at using Accelerated Reader, with some children having read more than 2 million words, this has had a massive impact on comprehension. This term we are going for a final push to see how many of the children can get to a million words.



Topic

This term Kelso's Topic will be Crime and Punishment. This topic will look at how the punishment for crimes has changed through history and how the past has influenced society today. They will have the opportunity to look at famous historical figures such as Simon De Montfort and Oliver Cromwell. In Science we are looking at scientists and inventors and will be looking at famous people from all branches of science including David Attenborough and Leonardo Da Vinci. In English we are going to begin by looking at the Shakespeare playscript of Macbeth, the children will have the opportunity to write their own narrative based on this text as well as a persuasive text. In Religious Education we will be learning about Sikhism and how they worship and how it promotes equality.
