Curriculum

This term we will start a new topic all about The Commonwealth. Looking at how it was started, which countries are part of it, why it is important and some famous people who have had a big influence on the world.

In English we will be writing non-chronological reports and limericks which should be great fun.

In RE we are looking at Christianity and 'Do Christians have to believe in God as a Trinity'. We will look at The Trinity, 'The Grace' and Roman Catholic Church.

Reading reminder:

Reading last term was very poor by a large proportion of the class - please remember that your child needs to read **three times a week as a minimum**. Children who do not read at home a minimum of 3 times by Thursday morning will read during their Thursday breaktime. We had a number of children missing their break each week due to not reading at home - this was also evident in their AR tests. Please sign your child's Reading Diary when they have read. This doesn't always need to be to you - independent reading is also fine. The **Reading Diaries need to be in school every day** and will be checked each morning. Your child will receive Dojo points for reading at home and completed AR tests.

Class Dojo

The children will continue to gain Dojo points for positive behaviours but also lose them for negative behaviours in line with the school behaviour policy.
