Summer Term 2

I hope you are all excited about coming back to school and we look forward to welcoming you into Westminster.

Topic

This term, in Westminster bubble, our topic is "Around the World". We will be looking at the countries that make up the United Kingdom and we will be looking in more detail at a variety of other countries, including Australia and America. During Art we will look at different artists or artwork that are native to that country, for the United Kingdom we will explore the artwork of Banksy.

Reading and Literacy

We are looking at a range of traditional tales this term, including Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Three Little Pigs. We will then be focussing on different ways of exploring the books and then writing for different purposes, which will include retelling the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and the Wolf writing a letter of apology to the Three Little Pigs.

We are unable to provide the children with reading books to bring home at this time but I would like to encourage the children to try and share a book from home as often as possible.

Maths

Our maths work will start of with reading, writing and ordering numbers up to at least 20. Then we will be looking at the features of a variety of coins and counting using different coins. We will also be looking at the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes, finding these shapes in the environment and discussing them using mathematical language. Looking at one more and one less than a given number and also halving and doubling numbers. Finally we will be able to name the days of the week, the months of the year and discuss the four seasons.

Science

In science we will learn about plants. We will be investigating what plants need to grow, labelling the different parts of a plant, how plants grow and what these changes look like across the seasons. Further to this they will also look at where food comes from and will go on a walk to discuss their senses.

P.E

The class has PE on a **Monday** with Miss McHamilton and then with Mrs Lacey on Wednesday. I would like to remind parents to please send their children in wearing their P.E. clothes for these days as we are unable to help them.

Homework

Homework is not being set this term but as discussed with reading, I would like to encourage children to share a book at home as often as possible.
