**Children whose forms are received after this date will only be allocated a place in a club if there are any spare places left.**

**All clubs will begin week commencing 20<sup>th</sup> September**

To apply for a place in a club, please complete the form in this booklet and return it to the school office by the date specified. You will receive notification to confirm whether your child has been allocated a place. Some clubs are heavily oversubscribed and whilst we cannot guarantee it, we try to ensure that all children will have the opportunity to participate in those clubs at least once a year.

With the exception of Taekwondo, please do not assume that your child will automatically be enrolled in a club due to their attendance in a previous term.

As places are limited, the school places an expectation of both attendance and high standards of behaviour on all those enrolled. If children consistently fail to attend or their behaviour falls below what is considered acceptable, their place will be offered to another child.

If children who normally go home from school on the taxi wish to attend a club, they will need collecting by parents/carers at the end of the club.

*Please do not rely on after school clubs for childcare, as although we try very hard not to cancel clubs, we sometimes have to due to staff illness or training.*

**Please ensure that your child is collected promptly at the end of each club. Children who are collected late from clubs on a regular basis may be removed from the club.**
