#### Dear Families,

We continue to follow the advice from Public Health England (PHE) and the Department for Education (DfE) in regards to how we try and stop the Coronavirus spreading in school and what to do if people feel unwell and the travel advice from the Foreign and Commonwealth Office. This is a very fast-moving situation as the UK has moved from the 'containment' phase to the 'delay' phase.

#### What is happening in school now?

Regular hand washing, personal hygiene lessons, not shaking hands etc. Children and staff to self-isolate for 7 days if they have a continuous cough or a high temperature. Visitors given hand sanitizer at assemblies and chairs spaced further apart.

## What may happen in the coming days?

There are a number of measures we may take, like for example temporarily stopping having family assemblies or temporarily stopping assemblies altogether, reduce other whole school events and the cancellation of school visits to crowded places. These measures will come into effect following DfE and PHE advice or if we believe they are necessary.

#### Will the school close?

At present, schools will only close if they are specifically told so – such as if a pupil or staff member contracts COVID-19. If the school is advised to close, we are able to send work home via Class Dojo. Please ensure that we have your details in school.

As a reminder, if you or your child have any known symptoms, (fever, continuous cough, breathing difficulties) please do phone 111 and self-isolate for 7 days until any concerns are alleviated. Due to information being updated so regularly, it is best for families to go to <u>https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus</u> for up to date information.
