#### **Swineshead Parking**

#### **Curriculum Updates**

We are really pleased to announce that we are expanding our Little Wandle phonics and reading provision to pupils in Year 2 and beyond. Our new reading books are aimed to improve fluency and create confident readers. Each book has six chapters, and the scheme includes detailed lesson plans and word sheets for staff to use in school and the beautiful reading books will then come home with your child.

We are also rolling-out a new spelling scheme for our Year 2 pupils. Little Wandle Spelling is a spelling programme designed to provide a seamless link from the main Little Wandle Letters and Sounds programme to learning spelling in Year 2. The programme aims to build on children's knowledge of the alphabetic code and teaches them to spell with confidence. Spelling is taught and practised in every lesson in Year 1. The programme teaches children to segment words into sounds and write the grapheme for each identified sound.

#### **New Staff / Staff Changes**

As is the way in any large organisation, some staff changes are inevitable. You know we said goodbye to a few staff at the end of last term and we welcome new staff in this term. Mr Edwards has already made a fantastic impact in Fountains Class and is looking at providing a future Drumming Club and Mrs Simpson and Miss Stancer have settled into Regents beautifully. Miss Mclean and Ms Street are fantastic permanent editions to our teaching team and both classes appear very settled and organised. In addition, I am sure you join us in sending love and congratulations to the new Mr and Mrs Baker (née Brown) and Mr and Mrs Walton (née Westfield). We also welcome Mr Shaw as the new KS2 Leader at Sutterton and Miss Parr as the new EYFS/KS1 Leader at Swineshead.
