Homework REMINDER!

Homework will be given out weekly, on a Friday, and should be handed in the following Wednesday at the latest. There will be two pieces of homework (GPS and Maths) as well as spellings (these will be stuck in their Reading Diaries). Our spellings this term will be a combination of common exception words and curriculum related. **Spelling tests will take place on Wednesday.** Dojo points will be given for homework and spellings. **Children who do not hand in their homework by Wednesday morning will complete their homework during their Wednesday breaktime, as we go through the homework together on Wednesday afternoons to address any difficulties or misconceptions.**

Reading REMINDER!

Reading last term was very poor by a large proportion of the class - please remember that your child needs to read **three times a week as a minimum.** **Children who do not read at home a minimum of 3 times by Friday morning will read during their Friday breaktime.** We had up to 15 children missing their break each week due to not reading at home - this was also evident in their AR tests. Please sign your child's Reading Diary when they have read. This doesn't always need to be to you - independent reading is also fine. The **Reading Diaries need to be in school every day** and will be checked each morning by Mr Edwards. Your child will receive Dojo points for reading at home and completed AR tests.
