Reading REMINDER!

Reading last term was very poor by a large proportion of the class - please remember that your child needs to read three times a week as a minimum. **Children who do not read at home a minimum of 3 times by Friday morning will read during their Friday breaktime.** We had up to 15 children missing their break each week due to not reading at home - this was also evident in their AR tests. Please sign your child's Reading Diary when they have read. This doesn't always need to be to you - independent reading is also fine. The **Reading Diaries need to be in school every day** and will be checked each morning by Mrs Chitty. Your child will receive Dojo points for reading at home and completed AR tests.

The children will continue to gain Dojo points for positive behaviours but also lose them for negative behaviours in line with the school behaviour policy.
