Curriculum

This term we will continue our topic about The Commonwealth. However, we are now focusing on the Commonwealth Games; how they came about and the history behind the games.

In English we will be writing biographies and explanation texts.

In RE we are looking at Christianity and continuing the topic of 'Do Christians have to believe in God as a Trinity'. We will look at Quaker Christians, their beliefs about God and how they live.

Reading REMINDER!

Reading last term was very poor by a large proportion of the class - please remember that your child needs to read three times a week as a minimum. **Children who do not read at home a minimum of 3 times by Thursday morning will read during their Thursday breaktime.** We had a number of children missing their break each week due to not reading at home - this was also evident in their AR tests. Please sign your child's Reading Diary when they have read. This doesn't always need to be to you - independent reading is also fine. The **Reading Diaries need to be in school every day** and will be checked each morning. Your child will receive Dojo points for reading at home and completed AR tests.
